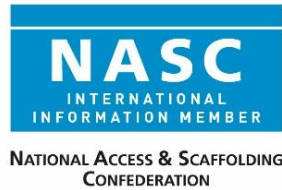

International Information Membership Criteria

NASC international information membership is open to all non-UK registered businesses which provide products or services to the access and scaffolding industry, or require products or services from the access and scaffolding industry.

NB This membership category is not open to scaffolding contractors or manufacturers/suppliers of scaffolding products which are covered by the NASC Code of Practice product audit.

In order to become a member an applicant must be able to demonstrate that it has met the following criteria:

Trading

The applicant must have been trading as a company or a limited liability partnership for 12 months and be able to produce if required financial statements for the period prepared by the accountants for the owners.

Insurance

The applicant must hold adequate levels of insurance appropriate to the business.

Training

Applicants which provide scaffolder training overseas must be a registered CISRS OSTS training provider.

Code of Conduct

Applicants must be prepared to abide by the NASC Code of Conduct and the NASC Bye Laws and Rules insofar as they apply.
